



The Clostridium Difficile (C. Diff) rate is calculated as a rate per 1000 patient days. The total “patient days” represents the sum of the number of days during which services were provided to all in-patients during the given time period.

The rate is calculated as follows:

$$\frac{\text{Number of new hospital acquired cases of C. Diff in HDH}}{\text{Total number of patient days for one month}} \times 1000$$

C. Diff rates may vary month to month; the smaller the facility; the greater the rates will vary. This is because a change in even one case in a small facility will cause the rate to go up or down considerably.
