Reporting to the Patient Care Manager, Rehabilitation Services, the successful candidate in this position will be responsible for performing at the full scope and accomplishing all related duties of a Physiotherapist in Rehabilitation Services in an acute care setting.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Successful completion of an undergraduate degree in Physiotherapy required;
- Masters degree in Physiotherapy preferred;
- Current registration in good standing with the *College of Physiotherapists of Ontario*
- Basic Cardiac Life Support certified;
- Demonstrated ability to deal effectively and cooperatively with all levels of patients, staff, physicians and public;
- Excellent professional judgment, conflict resolution and interpersonal communication skills with patients, families, team members, students and community partners;
- Competence in the practice of evidence-based Physiotherapy and inter professional care, with experience in the application of practice models and outcome measures;
- Practice reflects the standards of the *College of Physiotherapist of Ontario* and related professional organizations;
- Understanding and compliance with Occupational Health and Safety program;
- Knowledge and adherence to Infection Control principles;
- Must be self-directed with ability to work with minimal supervision;
- Ability to effectively collaborate with and delegate to the Rehab Assistant;
- Works in collaboration with the multidisciplinary health care team;
- Ability to assess mobility aids and equipment needs of patients ;
- Advocates and supports a culture of patient safety and demonstrates an understanding of how the department service and assigned responsibilities contribute to overall patient safety at HDH through patient safety knowledge, skills and attitudes;
